

Talents 2012 . Cinematic Thinking

Young photographers and art critics wanted!

The exhibition series **Talents** is successfully entering into its seventh year. **Photographers up to the age of 35** can apply for this unique european program with representative samples of their work until **December 16st, 2011**.

Supporting newcomer and giving them a chance in the future – Talents is an experimentation space for young international contemporary photography and art criticism. Since 2006, in the Talents exhibition series, C/O's e.V. has been promoting young photographers and art critics at the threshold between education and career, thus providing combined support to new talent in visual and text media.

Talents is an international competition held annually. The jury of professional judges selects four photographers and four art critics each year from the submitted entries. Their work is presented in four solo exhibitions at C/O Berlin over the course of the year and at the Goethe Institutes in Washington and Stockholm. Each solo exhibition is accompanied by a publication in which images and text enter into dialogue: talented young artists present themselves and their projects to a broad public, open up their work for discussion, and thus create a public forum.

In 2012, the Talents series will focus on the theme of **Cinematic Thinking**. Engagement with the medium of film has become ever more central to photography in recent years. This can be seen in the increasing exploration of film production processes, experimentation with narrative structures, and references to film aesthetics and film myths. How can photography adapt film structures and simultaneously break them open? What strengths do still images have over moving pictures? Photography in the classical sense, with its conventional wall presentation, can be expanded through the utilization of projection and installation strategies, thereby creating new possibilities for reflecting on the medium of photography itself.

How do I apply? Photographers up to the age of 35 can submit up to 15 samples of their work in print form – maximal size DIN A4, no originals. A short project description should accompany the photographs, as well as the online application form. A fee of 20 Euros will be raised.

Please note: art critics can apply anytime.

Amongst all submitted works a jury will select the 4 best pieces to participate in the Talents series in 2011.
